HEAT GUNS AND HAMMERS COMBINED with the elbow grease and energy of seventeen volunteers who met at our Original at 5597 Apple Court on Saturday, August 31st made the first Apple Court House Volunteer work session a success. The crew removed rusty nails from the exterior, old tile that covered the living room ceiling, and 1950s era pink plastic tile from the bathroom walls. “Our great volunteer team got a lot done today” said Society president Robb Nowak. “Our Original house is getting the TLC it deserves and is well on its way to becoming a Showplace of Greendale History!”

The pleasant fall day allowed the crew of volunteers to work on the exterior and interior of the historic Apple Court house. A priority is the restoration of the original wood windows where quality materials and expert workmanship are still evident. Plaster walls need cleaning, spot repairs, and paint to once again provide the house with a home-like feel.

The utility room roof will be replaced. Bob Sokolowicz helped remove damaged shingles. “The roof is pretty solid underneath,” he said. Blue tarp will cover it until a new roof is installed by Al Emmons’s volunteer crew.

Greg Sylvester “really enjoyed seeing the original living room hardwood ceiling reappear” as the white acoustic tile came down. The ceiling is in great shape and with a bit of cleaning will display the charm of the original 1930s design.

Volunteers, funds, and contributions are needed. The plan is to restore the exterior to as-built appearance, restore and renovate the interior, and add improvements and safety features for daily, overnight, and other special uses. Tea Time at the Guesthouse on Clover Lane


